



Nicos Severis Cyprus Junior Open 2023

Eléa Estate Golf Course, Cyprus

10 – 12 February 2023

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. ELIGIBILITY & HANDICAP LIMIT

Youth players (boys and girls) residing in Cyprus or internationally who are 18 years old or under as of 1 January 2023 and are in possession of a WHS HI of 9.0 or below for boys and 14.0 or below for girls. **At Registration, entrants (other than CGF Federated members) must produce proof of current handicap certified within 5 days of the competition start date, i.e. certified on or after 6 February 2023.**

2. ENTRY APPLICATION AND FEES

- Applications for Entry must be made through the online Entry Application Forms found on the CGF's website for each Championship ([Boys](#) or [Girls](#)) or from the event's pages on the CGF's website, no later than Monday, 6 February 2023. The closing date for Entry Applications may be changed and a Waitlist created at the discretion of the Tournament Committee. Should a Waitlist be created, preference will be given to international players and those with low handicaps.
- The **Entry Fee** for either Championship (Boys and Girls) is **€75** and includes 4 rounds of golf (practice round and 3 competition days), practice balls on competition days, daily snacks on completion of Rounds 1 and 2, prizes and a Closing Ceremony/Prize giving function including a buffet lunch on the final day. In the event of withdrawal after the closing date for entry, the entry fee will not be refunded.

3. FORM OF PLAY

The Championship is a 54-hole stroke play World Amateur Golf Ranking (WAGR) event, handicap qualifying, using the Black tees for Boys and the Yellow tees for girls, and played in accordance with the rules of golf as approved by the R&A, the Cyprus Golf Federation, and any Local Rules endorsed by the Tournament Committee.

4. TROPHIES

The boy player with the lowest gross score over 54 holes will be the **Nicos Severis Cyprus Junior Boys Open Champion 2023**, while the girl player with the lowest gross score over 54 holes will be the **Nicos Severis Cyprus Junior Girls Open Champion 2023**. In the event of a tie for either Championship, there will be a "sudden death" play-off over hole 18, repeated if required. For ties for all other prizes, countback procedures will apply. The Championship trophies will be retained in the offices of the Cyprus Golf Federation, while each Champion will receive a "keeper" trophy. Net trophies will be available, while on Day 3 a Hole-in-One prize will be available on a par 3 hole.

5. BUGGIES, TROLLEYS AND CADDIES

This is a walking competition, and no buggies may be used, except in the case of players with Official Registered Disabled status. Electric or manual trolleys may be used. Caddies are allowed but must register with the Registrar on a daily basis. For rules regarding caddies refer to the document [CGF Terms of Competitions](#) as published on the CGF's website.

6. LIVE SCORING

During play for all competition days, Live Scoring will be in operation, with scorers posted at predetermined places. Participants are required to cooperate with and assist the scorers in performing their duties.

7. REGISTRATION

Registration opens between 0800 and 1330 at Eléa Estate GC on Thursday, 9 February 2023, the official practice day. Any player unable to register by 1330 must call +357 96 533813 to confirm his/her participation.

8. PRACTICE

Players wishing to book their practice round on Thursday, 9 February, should make direct contact with Eléa Estate GC pro shop **in advance** (Tel: + 357 26 202004 email: golfshop@eleaestate.com). Additional rounds on previous days subject to availability may be booked at a discounted fee of €38.

9. MEDICAL CARE

During play, a doctor will be on call at player's own expense.
